

RTTC RULES

- At all times be considerate and respectful to others in the clubhouse.
- Play at your own risk.
- **Sign-in** before the start of play is **mandatory**. **Print full name legibly**.
- Shoes worn in the clubhouse must be non-marking tennis shoes.
- Food and drink, including water, are not allowed anywhere on the courts. Spilled liquid is a falling hazard.
- No dogs are allowed in the building.
- No alcohol is allowed at any time in the clubhouse.
- Non-resident guests, including children, must be accompanied by a resident or member sponsor at all times. See Guest Policy.
- Children may use club paddles and balls but no other club equipment, including pick-up buddies.
- Open play hours: non-member residents and accompanied guests are welcome to play during open play hours as indicated on the Play Schedule posted on the bulletin board. However, members have table priority when all five tables are in use.
- If all tables are in use, new players must wait 20 minutes before requesting a table. Check the sign-in log to determine those who have played the longest time. RTTC members have priority; non-member Rossmoor residents and guests must leave the table. A single player follows this same rule.
- In consideration of others, players should keep loud noise to a minimum.
- Eight white balls should always be in the holster at each table **before** and **after** play.
- At all times be considerate and respectful to others in the clubhouse.
